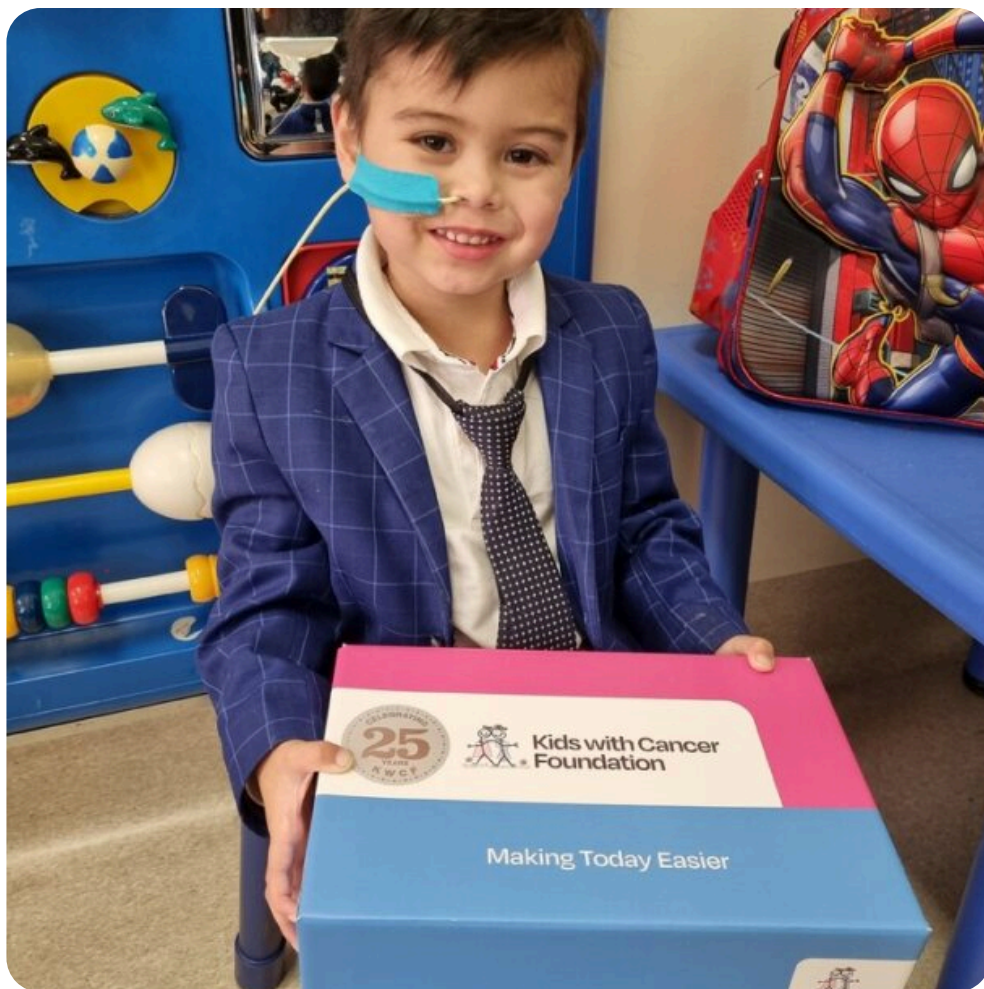

Our Vision

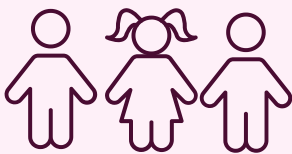
A world where a child's cancer diagnosis becomes an unremarkable event in life.

In Australia, more than 1000 children and adolescents are diagnosed with cancer each year

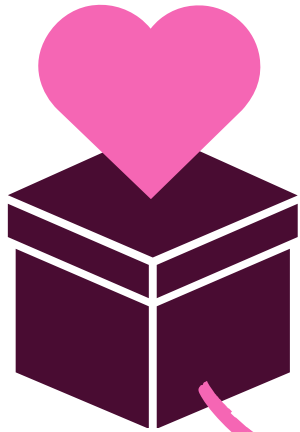


The overall survival rate for childhood cancer has now risen to over 80% thanks to medical research

Hope delivered

The Care Pack program was created to brighten the day of children undergoing cancer treatment. Aimed at children aged 0-18, these packs are designed to ease the burden of prolonged hospital visits by providing snacks and engaging distraction items such as fidget toys and activity books. By offering these thoughtfully curated packs, we strive to make both planned and unexpected hospital visits more manageable and less daunting for young patients and their families.

Each Care Pack brings comfort and a sense of normalcy to children during their treatments. The inclusion of nutritious snacks helps maintain energy levels, while the distraction items provide much-needed relief from the stress and anxiety of hospital stays. Ultimately, the Care Packs enhance the hospital experience, offering moments of joy and distraction in an otherwise challenging environment.

How you can get involved

Corporate Sessions

As part of a Corporate Volunteer or Community day, we offer the option of having these sessions either in our warehouse or in your office or alternative venue. The corporate sessions involve writing inspirational cards, building, filling and packing the Care Packs with snacks, activities, and toys, that is both efficient and fun. These packs then get sent to the hospitals we support around Australia! A care pack session has the potential to pack enough to cover the interstate Care Packs for the entire month!

At KWCF Offices

- Corporate partners to cover the cost of the number of care packs packed per session (this is a tax deductible donation)
- A 2 hour session based on a team of 10 - 15 people can pack approximately 150 care packs

At Corporate Offices

- Corporate partners to cover the cost of the care packs packed per session (this is a tax deductible donation)
- A 2 hour session based on a team of 20 - 30 people can pack approximately 250 care packs
- Corporate partners to cover the cost of the courier to send the care boxes from corporate offices to each hospital Nationwide
