WHY WE NEED YOUR SUPPORT

IN 2023, THERE WERE 1,240 CHILDREN AND ADOLESCENTS AGED 0-19 YEARS DIAGNOSED WITH CANCER ACROSS AUSTRALIA.

CANCER KILLS MORE CHILDREN THAN ANY OTHER DISEASE IN AUSTRALIA. EVERY WEEK THERE ARE THREE CHILDREN / ADOLESCENTS THAT WILL DIE FROM CANCER IN AUSTRALIA.

70% OF CHILDREN WHO SURVIVE CANCER SUFFER LONG-TERM EFFECTS FROM THEIR TREATMENT.

IN AUSTRALIA, CHILDHOOD CANCER SURVIVAL RATES HAVE RISEN TO OVER 80%, THANKS TO MEDICAL RESEARCH.

KWCF CHARITABLE PROGRAMS



FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

Social Workers refer eligible families of a child aged 0-18 years receiving cancer treatment to apply for financial assistance through the KWCF online portal.

We provide urgent petrol and grocery vouchers for families and pay bills including utilities, rent, mortgage payments, car registration and repairs, school fees, phone bills and funeral costs.

CANCER RESEARCH

KWCF funds vital cancer research projects across Australia - including a world-first Relapsed Ependymoma (brain cancer) Trial, testing a cutting-edge new technology.

It will mean there is something to offer kids who would otherwise have no other options.

CARE PACKS 4 KIDS

Children aged 0-18 are offered a Care Pack when they visit hospital for their cancer treatment or appointment.

Care Packs contains snacks for kids, coffee/tea for parents and distraction items such as fidget toys and activities to help children cope better with their visit.

KWCF Care Packs make the visit to hospital (both planned and unexpected) that little bit easier for kids and their families, who may have just received a diagnosis for their child or had minimal sleep.

KWCF supplies trolleys in some hospital oncology clinics stocked with additional snacks and items, allowing kids and families to help themselves to something extra.

WIGS 4 KIDS™

Our Wigs 4 Kids™ program supplies a wig, free of charge, to any child up to the age of 18 who has lost their hair during cancer treatment. Wigs are typically unaffordable for a family who is already experiencing financial hardship following a health crisis, and hair-loss for some children is a huge part of their identity.

Families can request a professionally made wig for their child - matched to their natural hair colour - providing them with improved confidence, self-esteem and reassurance to help them maintain a sense of normalcy during their cancer journey.

Individuals can send hair donations direct to our wig-maker to support the program.

HOSPITAL FUNDING

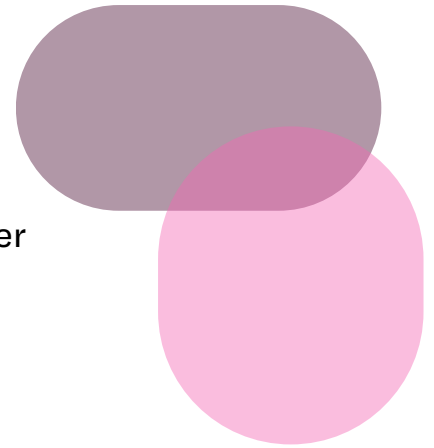
KWCF funds major Capital projects and 20 critical clinical positions in six paediatric oncology units across Australia.

These positions include Fellows, Researchers, Social Workers and Clinical Nurse Consultants.

WORKPLACE GIVING PROGRAM

Match your staff donations, to double your impact.

\$6 per fortnight from two employees over one year could provide one \$300 Grocery or Petrol Voucher

\$20 per fortnight from one employee over one year could fund 520 Care Packs for kids in hospital

\$50 per fortnight from 127 employees over one year could fund a Senior Oncology Welfare Worker to provide kids and their family with coping mechanisms relating to their diagnosis and discharge planning

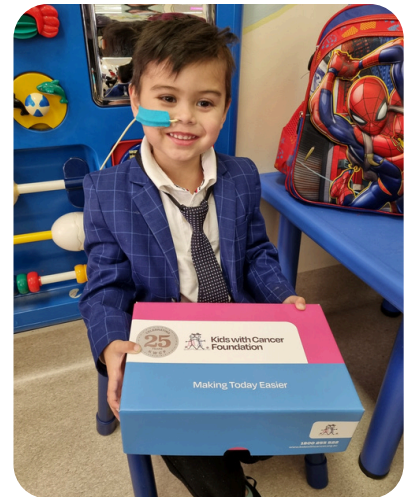
\$10 per fortnight from 11 employees over one year could provide one wig for a child with cancer

\$31 per fortnight from 10 employees over one year could provide one month of rent relief for two families
